




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### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE**

#### **SVD** Tradition in Higher Learning





#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three year degree course leading to the Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Science must have passed the H.S.C. (Std. XII) examination conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

#### OR

Must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certi ?cate (Std. XII) examination with vocational subjects / minimum competency based vocational course conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

#### OR

Must have passed the examination of another University or Body recognized as equivalent to Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) Examination.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

1. To fill the University of Mumbai Pre-Registration Form 2021-22 byvisiting the website: <u>http://mum.digitaluniversity.ac</u>

Select the College: **ST. ARNOLD NIGHT DEGREE COLLEGE** with the College Code is 1207. Take the hard copy/soft copy of the per-registration form 2021-22 and keep it ready before you proceed.

- 3. Please fill the online form and keep the scanned copies of the following documents which are to be uploaded:
  - Passport size photograph (80 × 107 pixel/10KB file)
  - Signature copy (80 × 35 pixel /10 KB file)
  - University Pre-enrolment Form.
  - HSC Mark Sheet.
  - HSC Leaving Certificate.
  - SSC Passing Certificate.
  - Any other certificate as applicable. (ex. Physically Handicap, Children with special needs like learning disability etc.)

- 4. Other Documents needed to be submitted are -
  - (i) Photocopy of Aadhar Card.
  - (ii) Photocopy of valid Caste Certificate, if belonging to any Reserved Category.
  - (iii) Baptism Certificate from Church (If Candidates applying for Minority Quota)
  - (iv) Gap Certificate for Candidates having gap of more than two years in their Education between passing the SSC and HSSC.
- 5. Candidates passed the H.S.C. from other than Maharashtra State Board will have to submit -
  - (i) Original and photocopies of Mark Sheets and Passing Certificate of H.S.C./equivalent of XII Std. Examination.
  - (ii) Original and two photocopies of Transfer / Leaving Certificate.
  - (ii) Original and two photocopies of Migration Certificate (In the event there is no practice of issuing Migration Certificate by the Board, the candidate shall produce a letter to this effect from the Board)

#### Note:

The Student is required to submit the original documents as and when demanded by the College Authorities.

- 1) On successful uploading/submission of the pre-admission form of the College along with the documents, the application will be verified by the Admission Department of the College.
- 2) Incomplete Admission forms or forms with incorrect information will be rejected.
- 3) All verified and approved forms shall be considered for selection in the merit list. The merit list shall be displayed on the College Notice Board and Website.
- 4) On selection in the Merit List, students shall receive an SMS and an email regarding the admission process, fee details and the payment procedure.
- 5) Admissions will be confirmed after payment of fees within the time schedule prescribed. The student shall lose the claim for admission from the merit list concerned if the fees are not paid within the stipulated time frame.

#### Note:

The admission will remain purely on PROVISIONAL basis till the receipt of confirmation of enrolment from University of Mumbai.

Candidate should have a valid **Email Id** and **MobileNumber** for mails and SMS from University of Mumbai regarding the application status.

#### **Cancellation of Admission or Refund of Fees:**

Cancellation of Admission or refund of Fees is subjected to the procedure laid down by the University of Mumbai or the Government Authorities. (Circular No. UG/412 of 2008)

The relevant circular is available on the College Website.

### **DISCIPLINARY RULES AND REGULATION**

Students joining the College have to strictly abide by the Rules and Regulations of the College.

- 1) Every Students must wear the Identity Card which must have his / her Photograph attested and basic personal information with Blood Group whenever he/she is in the College Premises.
- 2) If any student found guilty in any incident of ragging, strict disciplinary action against him / her will be initiated by the concerned Authorities.
- 3) The Student must not loiter in the College Premises while the classes are going on.
- 4) Smoking & Consumption of alcohol in the College Premises or entering after consuming alcoholic drinks in the College Premises is strictly prohibited.
- 5) No Student shall collect any money or contribution for Picnic, Trips, Educational Visits to some Place, Get-together, Study Notes, charity or any other Activities without prior sanction of the Principal.
- 6) Students are expected to take proper care of College Property and help the College Authorities in keeping the Premises clean. Damaging College property (like furniture & fittings/misuse of AC etc.) is breach of discipline and the guilty will be duly punished.
- 7) Students should not leave their books, valuables and other belongings in the classroom.
- 8) It is the responsibility of the Students to read the Notice Boards regularly for important announcements made by the College Office from time to time.
- 9) Use of Mobile Phone and handled devices are not allowed on Campus. For this default, the devices shall be confiscated.
- 10) Students using unfair means at examination will not be readmitted to the College. Action will be initiated against such students as per the norms and procedure prescribed by the University of Mumbai.

### **INFRASTRUCTURE / FACILITIES**


#### **CLASS ROOMS**

#### PARENTS TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (PTA)


