The Institute of Indian Culture, Swami Vivekanand Night College of Arts & Commerce, St. Arnold's Night Degree College of Arts & Commerce and B.M. The NSS aims for the development of the students personality through community services. Considering the aim, different activities were organised by the Unit as under-



Word Environment day was celebrated with a theme "Ecosystem Restoration". Saplings were Planted by Students& Teachers and Wall Painting was drawn on College Building to commemorate the themeby Students.

On **International Yoga Day**, Mind & Body workout by Iyengar as well as Mysore style was practiced by the Students as well as Teachers. Various classical Asanas as well as breathing practices were also done.

Online Workshop was organised on **Disaster Management** and Preparedness. Under the Campaign of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" a Fitness Drive was followed with the theme of "**FIT INDIA FREEDOM RUN - 2**" for 11 days. All the Volunteers along



with the people residing around the College area did the daily exercise like - jogging, physical training and stretching under expert guidance. Along with physical fitness, basic Yoga exercises was also practiced for immunity to the body and mind both.



The girls Volunteers distributed the packets of **Sanitary Pads to** the girls & women in the slum area around Mahakali and explained the hygiene things to them. They explained the health threats to our body due to unhygienic behavior during the Menstrual period to the women. They also gave tips to be followed during this period.

Blood Donation Camp was organised at Andheri Railway Station with the partner Blood Bank of Babu Jagjivan Ram Railway Hospital. Fully vaccinated Volunteers did the canvassing to the every passers by on the Station for Blood



donation. That tested their motivating skills. 83 people (Highest Number among all Colleges present) could be convinced and donated the Blood . Volunteer from SY BSC Gajendra Singh collected Highest Donors single handedly - 23.



The Volunteers collected 51 **Bed Covers** from the residents from the nearby area of the College, washed them and thendistributed it to the Migrant workers families residing in Andheri (East).



Paper Bag making activity was conducted in the College. All volunteers collected the old news paper from their vicinity and even from their own houses. They were trained to prepare paper bag of various types and sizes. Total 1200 bags were prepared which were distributed to small shops in the vicinity.



To commemorate the memories of Martyr Mahatma Gandhi, Beach Cleaning activity was conducted at Juhu by the Volunteers with the permission of the Authorities. The volunteers cleaned up the area of around 2 kilometers of the Sea Shore. The garbage was picked up and thrown away at the BMC Clean-up van and in the Containers. Also homage was paid to Gandhiji by singing his favaroite Bhajan "Vaishnav Jan to Tene Kahiyeje" and "De di hame azadi" along with the Members of Gandhi Seva Samaj. The importance of Gandhiji's teachings of cleanliness, self reliance for social welfare was remembered.

The Volunteers did the cleaning of the surrounding area of the **Sneha Sadan**, a Home for Homeless girls left alone by Parents or relatives.

Along with participating in different activities, the Volunteers attended online Programmes of Leadership Training, Shivaji Jayanti and Substance Abuse organised by the University.
